



Hello Centennial Academy parents and guardians,

We are just a few weeks away from Field Day, and I wanted to share some important updates and reminders to help everyone prepare.

All parents attending Field Day **MUST** have completed the mandatory chaperone/volunteer training. This requirement ensures the safety of all participants, helps staff clearly identify approved adults on site, and makes sure everyone understands Centennial and APS guidelines. Please note that parents should not bring additional children to Field Day, as this event is reserved for our scholars only.

Parent chaperones are welcome to ride the bus with scholars. However, if you plan to leave Field Day early, you will need to arrange your own transportation back to the school (e.g., Uber or Lyft). If you choose to drive, be aware that parking in the area is limited, and parking on the right side of the street is not permitted.

Before Field Day, all attending parents will receive a wristband and a Field Day shirt. These items are required so staff can easily identify approved participants. Additionally, please be aware that early dismissals will not be permitted at the Field Day location. Scholars must return to the school for dismissal.
