<p><b>Spring Screener Progress:</b> Dr. Hood shared progress on our spring screener data. We reviewed the school-wide data trends and discussed the growth and progress made in each grade level on the Star Early Literacy, Star Reading, and iReady Math Diagnostic.</p> <p><b>Georgia Milestones Results:</b> Dr. Hood shared that the score reports for Math and Science will be shared in late May. However, due to the new ELA standards and the scoring calibration required for the new ELA Milestones Assessment, the scores for ELA will not be ready until November.</p> <p><b>School Events:</b> Spring Fling went really well and raised money for the PTA. Some vendors did not get as much traffic as expected, so PTA may scale down on some of the vendors for next year. The community had great feedback as well.</p> <p>Classroom parties and awards are scheduled. Fifth grade will have special events specific to their grade level as well.</p> <p>Kindergarten Round-Up will happen this week. PTA will be there with Lucky and popsicles for our new kindergarten students.</p> <p>Field Days will be the second to last week. Volunteers are still needed. Feedback was provided about allowing the volunteers to transition with the grade level classes instead of staying with the station.</p>
