# Requirements for the 26 – 27 School Year

Annual student data updates must be completed prior to the upcoming 2026-2027 school year.

***This is important for your student to utilize the nurse's clinic and obtain treatment.***

## ***Mandatory Annual Back to School Update Instructions***

Parent or Court Ordered Legal Guardian; we have streamlined this process to make it quicker and easier for you:

1. Log into your Parent PowerSchool Portal
2. Click on FORMS in the left menu – to review, update & submit required forms:
  - BACK TO SCHOOL – Student Information
  - Back to School – Technology and Other Agreements
3. Click back on FORMS: If need to update or review, click & submit:
  - Medical History Update
  - Student Emergency Contact information

1. Your student will not be attending NEMS for the 26-27 school year as withdrawal procedures will need to be completed.
2. You need assistance with the annual update.

  - Guardianship/Custody Change
  - Moved outside of Noblesville Schools District
  - Student's name misspelled in PowerSchool

## ***SPANISH Only:***

If you have the portal set to Spanish, you may not see the FORMS. Please sign in using English, then go to FORMS and change language to Spanish on the top right of the screen.

After a Form is completed and another form pops up, you must keep changing the top right "language" box to Spanish each time.

# Counselors Corner

## **New Student Mental Health Care Resource**

We are pleased to announce that effective July 1, 2026 Aspire Indiana Health will be Noblesville Schools' new school-based mental health partner. Every Noblesville school is staffed with school counselors and social workers, and those services will remain in place. Aspire staff will supplement, not replace, the strong mental health supports already available in our schools. This change follows Community Health Network's recent announcement that it will no longer be providing in-school mental health care across the state. Impacted families and staff have received additional details. If you have any questions about school-based mental health resources for students, please contact your school counselor or social worker.

## **21st Century Scholars Program**

The Indiana 21st Century Scholars Program provides income-eligible students an opportunity to earn a scholarship that could pay up to four years of college tuition and fees. Automatic enrollment has currently taken effect for students on track to graduate high school in 2028 and 2029. Letters to the cohort of 2029 were sent May and August, 2025 to parents and guardians of students who have been automatically enrolled. Parents and guardians can see if their students are automatically enrolled by creating ScholarTrack accounts.

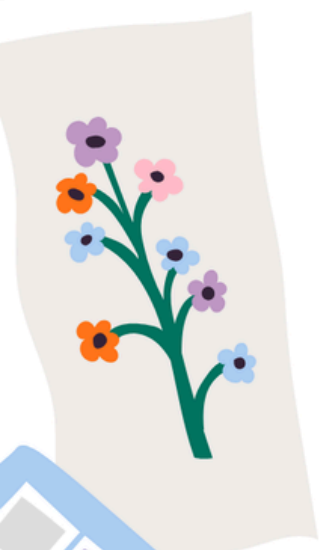




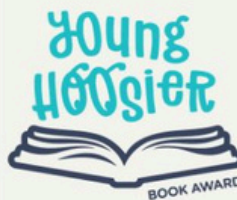

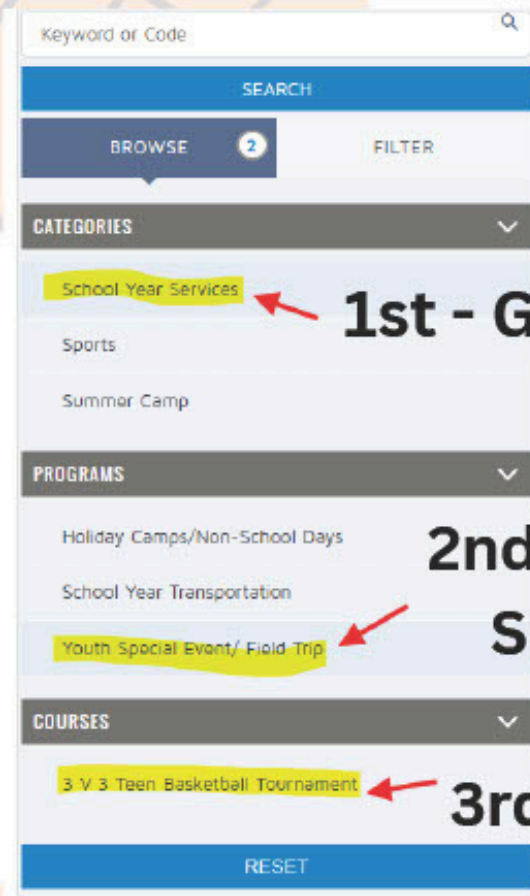
