To enroll in an AP Course for the 2026-2027 school year, this document must be signed and returned to Mr. Edwards (Counselor).

Tracy Charter School is committed to providing an environment in which all students have equal access to Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Students who enroll in AP courses are willing to meet the challenges of college level curriculum as directed by the College Board. Please visit www.collegeboard.org to review the AP program.

In order to ensure that our students are making an informed decision regarding enrollment in AP courses, Tracy Charter School needs both the student and their parent/guardian(s) signature on the contract.

Students are not allowed to drop AP courses.

Some considerations to keep in mind are:

1. Due to the college level curriculum taught in each of these courses, counselor or administrative approval is required to enroll in more than three (3) AP courses.
2. AP students are highly encouraged to register for the AP Exams (during the Fall), which are administered in May of each year.
3. AP courses are 18 weeks long and will be taught by an Edgenuity Instructor.

The staff and administrators are excited to provide an opportunity for students to take a college level academic course. We commend you for choosing this opportunity! The AP experience is rewarding and will help prepare you for your post-secondary education.
