Georgia Skare led the way, setting a new school record in the long jump with a leap of 17'7", breaking the previous record set by Julia Peinkofer in 2018.

First-place finishers included Ava Drabik in the 100 meters, Lena Musial in the 200 meters, Gabbie Aichinger in both shot put and discus, Hana Khan in the 400 hurdles, Maddie Dallas in the pole vault, and Kaleigha in the triple jump. The 4x100 relay team of Ava Drabik, Lena Musial, Maddie Dallas, and Georgia Skare also captured first place.

The Lady Red Hawks remain undefeated with a record of 4–0.
