**Turner:** Ms. Turner shared that majority of the information discussed was about budget policy. She encouraged members to read policy and provide feedback; she also recommended everyone to attend a meeting at least once.

Mrs. Turner and Mr. Scheifflee thanked out “rolling off” members for their time, service and dedication. Each new and old member had an opportunity to introduce themselves. Mrs. Lawson welcomed the new members and shared her role as a support SGC and she’s available to answer questions

### **7:41 AM** Discussion Item: Focus Group Results (All Members)

Mrs. Turner and Mrs. Shubha provided feedback obtained from the Staff Satisfaction focus group meetings held April 24<sup>th</sup>. The 3 big topics were Attendance/Discipline, Teacher Workload and Communication. Mr. Scheifflee reported that the focus group’s findings are similar to the analysis of the Staff Survey issued in January. Mr. Scheifflee shared

that during yesterday's faculty meeting, he made staff aware about the school's concern on communication. (There is a form staff can use to provide suggestions on improvements)

Based on the focus group transparency in consequences for skipping and tardies, the necessity of the form (and lack of reasons to use it); concerns why consequences aren't tied to exemption. Mr. Scheifflee explained that according to board policy, behavioral incidents cannot be used to determine eligibility for exemption.

There was a lengthy conversation about the need of both Canvas and Infinite Campus. A big concern shared was about discrepancy in grades. Mr. Scheifflee encouraged that parents should reach out to board members to share their experiences and concerns. Mrs. Lawson pointed at, that parents are making their concerns known.

**7:51 AM Informational Item:** Principal's Update, including school Store (Scheifflee)

Mr. Scheifflee explained that the grand opening for the school store is likely to be during September's Open House. Our school departure date, Friday May 22<sup>nd</sup>, will not allow enough time. It was proposed that the school uses at least \$10,000 of next year's funds to buy apparel. Mr. Kesarkar shared an idea from Cambridge, to invest the money in equipment that the print department can use to produce its own apparel rather than purchasing apparel. Mr. Scheifflee shared that he will contact Cambridge to gather additional information.

Mr. Scheifflee also provided updates about the success of our extracurriculars, sports and art. He reported that we have hired a new basketball coach. A formal announcement will go out once onboarding is completed. The school is in a good position for the start of the school year because AHS is 100% staffed. He also reminded us that the "school" will be housed at Innovation Academy during June and July.
