Mercy Collaborative Care (CoCM)

Collaborative care is available to patients with a Mercy provider and is covered by most insurance plans. The cost is often similar to primary care services.

- Your provider will let us know how to reach you.

- You can choose whether to talk to your clinicians by phone or video session. Collaborative Care is flexible so you can get support when you need it most.



- Your Collaborative Care clinician, alongside your provider, is now a part of your care team.

PRIMARY CARE OFFICE

Start here for most medical concerns, wellness care and chronic condition management.

GOOD FOR:

- Annual physicals
- Routine screenings
- Vaccines
- Sprains and strains
- Chronic conditions
- Medicine refills
- Colds and flu
- Asthma
- Anxiety and depression

MERCY ON CALL

Free after-hours advice on what to do about your medical concern or condition. Providers always on call. Available only to patients with a Mercy primary care provider.



WALK-IN CLINIC / URGENT CARE

Immediate care for minor illness or injury.

GOOD FOR:

- Colds and flu
- Minor cuts and burns
- Sprains and strains
- Cuts requiring stitches
- Broken bones
- Concussions
- Vomiting and diarrhea



EMERGENCY ROOM

The best place for serious medical conditions.

GOOD FOR:

- Fever in a child less than 3 months old
- Chest pain
- Shortness of breath
- Sudden numbness, weakness or speech difficulty
- Severe belly pain
- Coughing or vomiting blood
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Mental health crisis
