•PeeWee & Coach Pitch Baseball for Ages 3 thru 8

Register early so you don't miss out on all the fun! This very popular coed program is for children ages 3 to 8. Three divisions are offered; 3/4 year old division, 5/6 year old division, and 7/8 year old division. Score is not kept and the emphasis of the program is on learning and having fun. Program runs exclusively on Saturday mornings; practices on July 11th & 18th, followed by league games held on Saturdays which will wrap up on August 15th. Picture day is July 25th. Program times run between 8:30am and 1:00pm. Players will play a modified t-ball/coach pitch format.

Please see registration information and policies below:

- Pre-registration and payment of fees in advance is required for all programs. Please put dates/times of all clinics, camps and classes on your calendar and attend as you will **not** receive a reminder notification.
 - League registrations will receive phone/text notification from your child's coach detailing practice schedules.
 - Register by mail, e-mail, or online. ***No telephone registrations accepted.***
 - Confirmations and reminders are not sent.
 - Complete registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis (including payment of fees). If the class is full when we receive your registration form, we will contact you. Online registration system will show no space available when full.
 - Please make checks payable to City of Bonney Lake (COBL). A \$35 service fee is incurred for all checks returned NSF
 - Classes are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment is not met. For classes postponed, rescheduled or cancelled, a full refund will be made. **No refunds issued for missed classes, camps or clinics.** All other refunds incur a **\$20 processing fee plus any other expenses, per child, per offering.** Refund requests must be in writing to: recreation@cobl.us or recreation@bonneylake.gov
