## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

---

- Will Aquinas offer onsite physical exams at school?

Yes, June 2, 2026 from 5 PM – 7 PM and also on August 4, 2025 from 5 PM – 7 PM for a cost of \$40 (Only card payments will be accepted. Cash will not be taken).

- Where else can I take my child for a sports physical?

Primary care doctor, Chiropractors, Some CVS's provide sports physicals

- When should I complete the physical process in Privit?

Before and right after the Doctor's exam

- How do I obtain the paper physical exam forms to take to the Doctor?

In Privit, after you have completed the "Personal Details" section for your student, you may select the "Print Documents" button and will see a list of forms. You will select "KSHSAA Blank Physical Form" and print it.

- What should I do after the Doctor's visit?

Upload page 4 of the physical exam pages to Privit. Then complete any remaining forms in Privit (i.e. Concussion & Head Injury, Eligibility Checklist, KSHSAA Physical Consent, and the Consent Form and Liability Waiver).

- Will I be able to turn in paper forms to the Student Life Office instead?

No, you will need to utilize Privit.

- Can I change a Team Selection for my student?

Yes, you may change your student's Team Selection at any time.

- I printed the physical forms from KSHSAA's website and noticed the forms in Privit are different. Which forms should I use?

Use the Privit forms. All forms utilized in Privit are based on the current KSHSAA forms. Forms were digitized so the formatting looks a little different.
