

**John F. Miller School

1.0 Welcome and Roll Call

3.1 **Budget:** Lori had no new information on the budget.

3.2 **Title I/Title III:** Jean had no new information on these programs.

3.3 **Community Partners:**

- Jean discussed that Zappos would like to partner with Variety Club and the City of Las Vegas Adapted Recreation Department to host a fashion show at our school with 10 students, who would model adapted clothing sold Zappos. The students would be able to keep the clothing. Also, Zappos will be matching a \$500 donation from the City of Las Vegas Adapted Recreation Department, so \$1,000 will be donated to our school. Jean will be meeting with representatives from Zappos and the City of Las Vegas on February 6th to discuss more details.
- Jean discussed that representatives from the DMV will be coming to school in February to donate batteries to us, which they collected from their employees in support of our school.
- Lisa discussed the AI's Closet, sponsored by the Assistance League, will be establishing a clothing bank for students at our school. The new clothing will be donated and available to any student in need. As clothes are distributed, new clothing will be added to the closet. Lisa also reported that she is working with the Assistance League to allow our students to access Operation School Bell, which provides new clothing, shoes, and toiletries to students in need.
- Jean reported that Vegas PBS and the CCSD Communications Office will be on campus January 24th to film students. The footage will be used at the August Back-To- School Administrators' meeting and by PBS.

3.4 **Miscellaneous:** Lori discussed a possible partnership with NV Energy to provide our school direct access to the power grid across the valley in the event of a power outage. Representatives from NV Energy will be on campus January 23rd to look at our current set up, and we will be asking to keep our generator as a back-up system.
