MINUTES

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** -Meeting was called to order at 6:08pm.
2. **ROLL CALL**- See above
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT**- No public comment
4. **DISCUSSION OF THE 26-27 BUDGET** – Board of Education approved a budget of \$51, 586,550. The Town Council reduced the Board of Education budget by \$1,645,874. New allocation for Board of Education is \$49, 940, 6476. That is a \$2,001,859 increase over last year’s budget. Dr. Nash went over possible reductions in salaries, supplies, equipment, other, repairs and maintenance, and decision packages.
5. **DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING USE OF NON-LAPSING FUND**- Dr. Nash gave a breakdown of the non-lapsing fund. Uncommitted balance as of March 2026 is \$812,022. 24-25 contribution pending audit is estimated to be \$800,000. The estimated available balance after the 24-25 contribution with phase 1 of the access road is \$1,613,000. The amount in the non-lapsing fund without phase 1 of the access road is \$2,692,827. A discussion followed in support of removing the use of non-lapsing funds for phase 1 of the access road.

Motion: by Kyle Provencher seconded by Diane Summa that the Board of Education rescind its previous authorization to use \$1,079,827.98 from the non-lapsing account for Phase One of the access road project, as the project will instead be treated as a capital project.
