Course Descriptions

Consumer Education

Do you feel that you are ready for life after high school? Are you confident that you will have enough money to support yourself and live the type of lifestyle you want to live? By enrolling in Consumer Education, you will take the first step in preparing for a successful future by learning how to manage credit, invest for retirement, and budget everyday expenses. Students will also complete projects on buying a new home and buying a new or used car. Students will gain a greater understanding of basic economic concepts so they can make informed buying decisions and learn how to manage their money.

Credit Recovery

Fenton High School partners with Imagine Learning for our Credit Recovery classes. Imagine's online curriculum and learning solutions are designed to support all educators and students and can be easily customized to meet the unique needs of any student. This programming is done in conjunction with your child's counselor for specific coursework. Students can take this online course for credit recovery over the summer.

Driver Education - Course Fee of \$150

Driver Education, the classroom portion, includes existing and proposed rules of the road, and graduated licensing laws. Note: In order to be enrolled in Driver Education, state law requires students to have passed a minimum of eight courses during the previous two semesters.

Behind the Wheel - Lab Fee of \$200

Behind the Wheel is offered to students upon completion of the classroom portion of the course. Behind the Wheel is offered to students before and after school and in summer school. During the Behind the Wheel portion, the students are exposed to varying driving situations that emphasize motor skills, application of the laws, accurate judgment, properly timed correct responses, and driving emergencies. There is a lab fee for the Behind the Wheel phase of Driver Education to help defray the maintenance of the driver education vehicles. Fee: \$200.00. Registration for Behind the Wheel will be conducted at the appropriate time by the Driver Education staff.

English Extension - 1, 2 or 3

This opportunity is available for students who have not shown mastery in all essential learning outcomes during their English course and thus have not earned credit for the course. Students are provided support from certified English teachers to relearn concepts and display mastery of the outcomes they did not master. As students display mastery, credit for their English course will be issued. Placement in this opportunity is determined by the teacher of the student's current English course.

Math Extension - 1 or 2 (Math 3 is completed via Credit Recovery)

This opportunity is available for students who have not shown mastery in all essential learning outcomes during their math course and thus have not earned credit for the course. Students are provided support from a certified math teacher to relearn concepts and display mastery of the outcomes they did not master. As students display mastery, credit for their math course will be issued. Placement in this opportunity is determined by the teacher of the student's current math course and the Division Leader.

EL Summer Bridge

This program will target incoming freshman students who have achieved between a 2.5 and 3.5 as a composite score on the most recent ACCESS Test for English proficiency. The curriculum will emphasize literacy skills, reading and especially writing. A secondary goal of the course will be that the students will be able to start the school year with a clearer understanding of Fenton High School, the building, rules, and overall acclimation to life at the high school level. Students will learn about various resources available to them within the building and behavioral expectations for different classes. Students will also participate in a variety of field experiences within the Bensenville/Wood Dale community.

Incoming Freshmen Summer Matters Math Intensive

The Summer Matters Math Intensive Program is a proactive academic initiative designed to ensure every student starts their high school career on a path to success. This course serves as a vital "bridge," specifically curated for incoming freshmen whose MAP scores indicate they are on the cusp of Math 1 readiness. Rather than simply reviewing old material, this intensive program previews the critical logic and procedural skills required for Math 1. By strengthening foundational gaps now, students can bypass the frustration of early-semester struggles and instead build the "math momentum" needed to thrive in our high school curriculum. Placement in this program is determined by students' junior high MAP scores.
