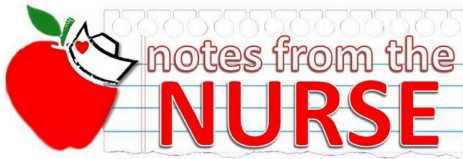

... Attention 6th Grade Parents: As the school year is starting to wind down, we thought it would be a great opportunity to remind parents of current 6th graders that their child is due for required immunizations prior to entering 7th grade.

As required by The Ohio Department of Health, all students entering 7th grade are REQUIRED to have the Tdap vaccine and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine. Please plan on getting these vaccinations before the start of the 2026-27 school year. You will need to obtain a copy of the most current immunization record (to include Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines) and turn it in to your child's school. Please contact your health care provider or the nurse at school with any questions.

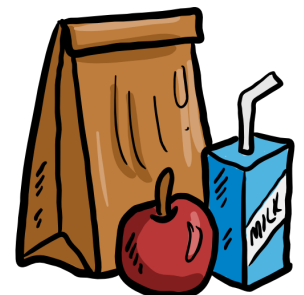

It's time to think about kindergarten registration

2025-26 Kindergarten and Alternative Kindergarten Registration

Parents/guardians may begin the Kindergarten Registration or Alternative Kindergarten Registration process by visiting our website and submitting an online Enrollment Express entry. To be eligible for Kindergarten for the 2025-2026 school year, your child must be five years of age by September 30, 2025. Any student whose birthday falls between May 1 and September 30, 2020 qualifies for the voluntary option of Alternative Kindergarten. Signing your student out Early? Need to change your student's end of day transportation plan?

With the end of the school year just around the corner and end of year activities starting up, we wanted to remind parents of the proper procedure to sign a student out early or change their normal end of day transportation plan.

★ Early Dismissals & Signing Students Out

Early Dismissals: If your child will be picked up from school early, please send a note or email (**with student's first and last name**) to school with your child on the day of early pick up. If somebody other than a parent/guardian will be picking your child up, please include their first & last name in the note (email) signed by the parent/guardian. **We will NOT release your child to ANYONE other than a parent/guardian without proper notification from the parent/guardian.** Upon arrival to pick up, we ask that you ring the bell at the school main entrance (A) where you will be let into the main office. The office staff will ask to see your (or designated person picking up) valid ID. Once your (or designated person's) ID has been verified the person picking up will be asked to sign the student out at the front office. We will get your student to the office as quickly as possible.

★ Students going home different than their "Normal Procedure" at the end of the day

Anytime your child will be going home after school different from their "Normal Procedure", please send in a note (or email) to your child's teacher. **Please include your child's first and last name.** If somebody other than a parent/guardian will be picking up your child, please include their name in the note signed by a parent/guardian. If calling our office to make a change in your child's transportation plan, please call us at (937) 578-6600 no later than 2:45 p.m.
