- [The Practice Keypad ID Number Sheet](#) ○ Although not required for Kindergarten, students can begin to memorize their Student ID # and practice where those numbers are on the keypad used in the meal line. Kindergarten students will be provided ID cards to scan at the beginning of the year for their meals and practice entering their ID numbers in the lunch line later in the year. Students are assigned the same ID number through 12th grade.

- Curious students may go through our meal lines (even if they ate breakfast at home or brought a lunch). ○ Students wishing to purchase a meal will be fed and charged for a meal (breakfast or lunch), whether or not funds are available, in accordance with HB 3454, unless purchase restrictions are requested.
