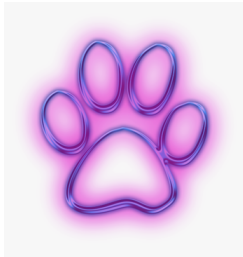

Work Permits

Even during the summer, work permits are still required for students who want to have a job. These permits help ensure that teens are working in safe, age-appropriate conditions and that employers are following youth labor laws.

For parents, work permits also provide reassurance and involvement—you'll know where your child is working and approve the arrangement ahead of time. It's an extra layer of protection while your teen gains valuable experience. It's also important to remember that the Oroville Union High School District grade and attendance requirements still apply, even over the summer. Students must remain in good standing to keep their work permit, reinforcing the importance of responsibility both on and off the job.

If you would like to obtain a Work Permit, the following steps will need to be completed:



Medications

If your student needs to take medication during the school day, a doctor's signed authorization form must be kept on file in the attendance office. Over the counter medications, such as Tylenol or Excedrin, are not allowed on campus, and must be left in the office with doctor permission only. Anyone with unauthorized medications is in violation of the district drug policy and may face disciplinary action. Please take any necessary medications to the Attendance Office and pick up a Medication Authorization form as soon as possible.

Online Parent Data Confirmation will open in July. Families should be on the lookout for an email with instructions on how to

complete the process.

2. Once forms are completely filled out by student, parents and the employer, they can be brought into the office. Please make sure all pages are complete! After forms have been received, grades and attendance will be checked in Aeries. If you have met the requirements, a work permit will be issued. This work permit will only be valid for the employer that is listed. If you have multiple jobs, you will need one for each job.

This step is important to ensure that your contact information, emergency details, and student records are accurate and up to date for the upcoming school year. Please check your inbox (and spam folder) and complete the confirmation as soon as possible once it becomes available.

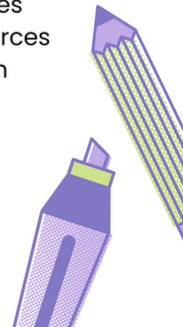
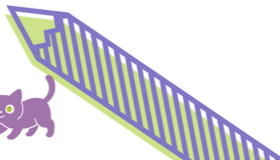
