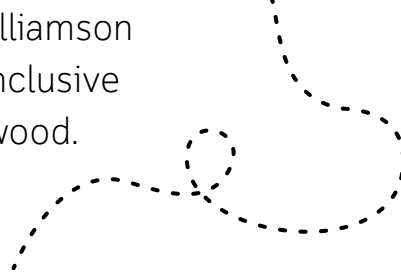
WILLIAMSON COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION

POOLS & SPLASH PADS

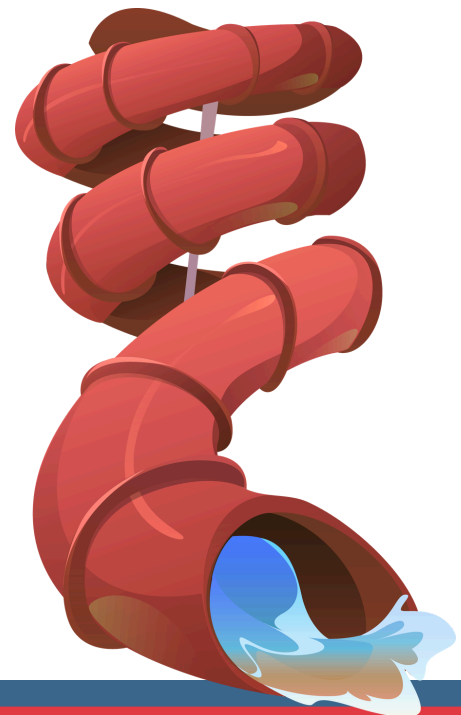
Need to cool off? Take a dip at the pools and splash pads around Williamson County.

BRENTWOOD

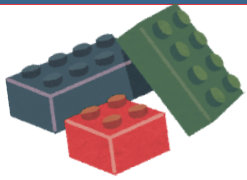
Brentwood offers a free concert series at Crockett Park. Come enjoy live music, food trucks, and fun!
