

Grad Nite Reminders 2026

- If you have a prescription, you will need to give it to the lead teacher on each bus (Hjelmstad, Merrill & VanWarmerdam) to hold while on the bus and will need to see the teacher to get the medication. If your medication needs to be brought into the park, let Mrs. Hjelmstad know so she can put it in the Head Chaperone Bag.
- Between now and the trip, we reserve the right to make any bus movements necessary. Your signed-up seat might change.
- Please download the Disneyland App **now**, that way your ticket can be scanned and saved on there in case you lose your ticket. This will also help with ordering food.
- Disneyland Dress Code reminder: Proper attire, including shoes and shirts, must be worn at all times. Clothing that drags on the ground is prohibited. Clothing with multiple layers is subject to search. Disneyland reserves the right to refuse admission or remove any person wearing attire that they consider inappropriate or attire that could detract from the experience of other guests. Costumes and masks may not be worn. Please wear comfortable shoes as there will be a lot of walking.
- You will need to be inside **Winter Gym by 3:00am** on May 15th. Each student will be checked-in and bags checked, then loaded on to the bus. The bus will depart MHS at 3:30am. If you are late, we **will not** wait for you!
- All items you are taking on the bus need to be placed in your bus line on the gym floor for inspection and all bags/coolers need to be open so they can be checked for inappropriate items. MPD will have dogs searching **all** items.
- **NO** previously-opened containers on the bus! All drink containers must be new and sealed. Any drink that is not sealed or not in a new container will be thrown away prior to boarding the bus. **NO FULL HYDROFLASKS or OPEN STARBUCKS CUPS (or similar items) ARE ALLOWED.**
- Wear comfortable clothes for the bus ride. We will stop once on the trip down. You can change at the Grapevine.
- You may bring a blanket and a pillow to sleep on the bus.
- If you want to listen to music on the bus, you **must** bring headphones.
- No **open** food or drink is allowed into the park from the bus!!! Disneyland **WILL** make you throw anything opened in the trash. If you want to take food, snacks, drinks, gum, or anything else, it must be originally sealed.
- We will enter the park around 12:00pm on Friday. Students will have Park Hopper Passes allowing them to visit both Disneyland and California Adventure. At 9:00pm, California Adventure will shut-down and become the official Grad Nite Party where all graduates and chaperones will be. At 2:00am, the Grad Nite Party ends and students will board the Disney Trams to the Toy Story Parking Lot. Busses will leave the Toy Story Parking Lot at 2:15am.
- Estimated time of arrival back to MHS is 9:30am on May 16th.
