SUN BUCKS is back!

SUN Bucks, the federal food benefit program once known as Summer EBT, is returning for summer 2026. SUN Bucks provides a \$120 lump-sum summer benefit per school-aged child for income-eligible families. Income eligibility standards are the same as those for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).
