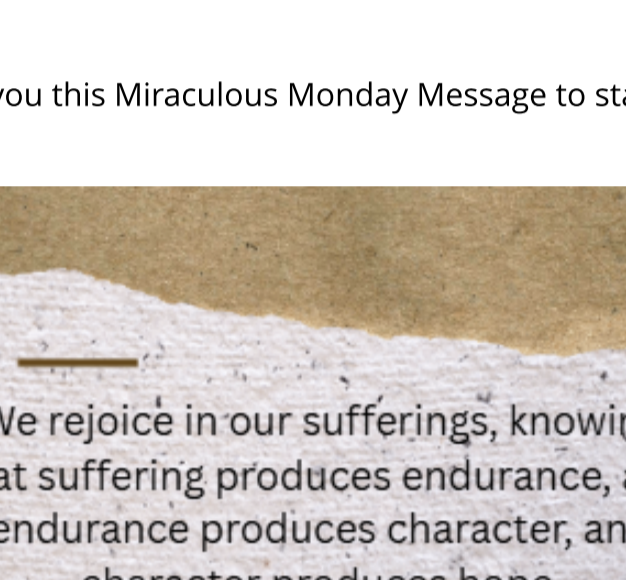
AP exams run through May 15 - students will be notified of the schedule and protocol beginning Monday, April 27.

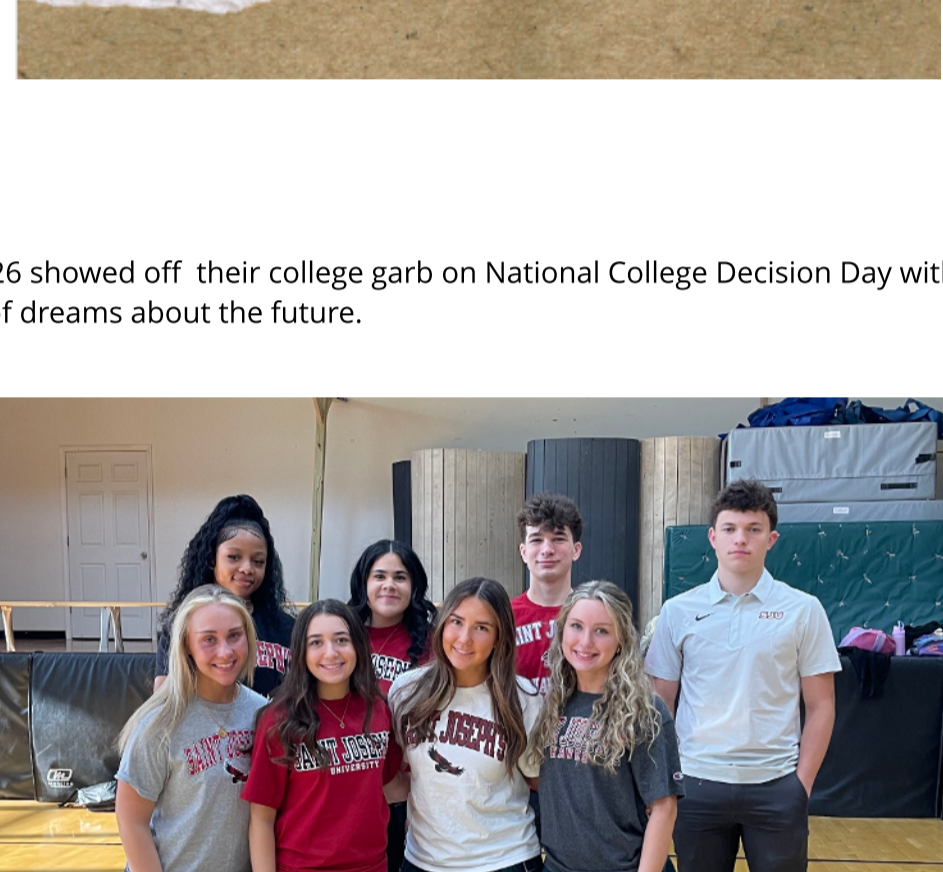
