

Scott County High School Graduates & Families,

We are thrilled to celebrate the Scott County High School Class of 2026 with you! If you attended our graduation ceremony last year, you know that a lot of people came out to support our graduates resulting in traffic congestion and parking difficulties for families and a delayed start of the ceremony. We have a plan to address these concerns and improve the situation for your graduate and family this year.

A carpool parking permit will be REQUIRED for any car to enter the Scott County High School campus on the day of graduation. Graduates will each receive two (2) personalized carpool parking permits. We encourage you to make plans now with your friends and family so you can meet up ahead of time and ride together to make full use of your carpool parking permits. Graduates will receive permits at the last required graduation practice.

The SCHS graduation ceremony will start at 10am on Saturday, May 30, 2026. Even with this new plan in place, it is wise to expect additional traffic and allow extra time to get to the stadium. Gates will open at 8:30am.

The only cars entering campus should be those with carpool parking permits. All cars will enter the SCHS campus from Long Lick Road. The main entrance will only be used as an exit on this day to ensure one-way traffic. The purpose here is to stack all cars on our campus so we do not block Long Lick and McClelland Circle and back up traffic for everyone. All cars will pass through a required checkpoint and anyone who does not have a carpool parking permit will be directed to exit campus to find alternative parking.

If you have BOTH a government-issued handicap parking pass AND a carpool parking permit that grants you campus entry, there will be reserved parking close to the stadium and you will be directed at the checkpoint. There will be no guest drop offs and a carpool parking permit is required for anyone wishing to park on the SCHS campus.

Guests without a carpool parking permit can park nearby at Anne Mason Elementary School or Royal Spring Middle School to take the free shuttle. Shuttles will drop guests directly at the gate and buses will be equipped with air conditioning and to accommodate those in wheelchairs, if needed. Return shuttles will be available starting at the end of the graduation ceremony.

Anne Mason and Royal Spring are the only shuttle pick up locations. There will be no guest parking at Scott County Middle School on Cardinal Drive and no shuttle pick up at Scott County's Brooking Park.

There will be numerous directional signs marking entry points and parking locations and a site map will be distributed to all SCHS graduates soon. For out of town guests, it might be helpful to provide addresses for each location, including shuttle stops, listed below.
