

Hello Parents of soon to be sixth graders....

I just wanted to send out a reminder...

The State of Connecticut requires all sixth grade students to have a physical examination. The Health Assessment/Immunization form must be completed in its entirety by the health care provider. The form will include: height, weight, blood pressure, vision, hearing, postural, speech, hemoglobin (HGB), hematocrit (HCT), gross dental, and health /developmental history as appropriate. Also, an assessment of risk of exposure to tuberculosis (TB) shall be conducted by a health care provider. Any student determined to be at high risk must be tested w/the test results recorded on the State of Connecticut health Assessment Record (HAR-3)

Results of these physicals must be reported to the school's health office using the State of Connecticut Department of Education Health Assessment Records.
