SENIORS: Community College Enrollment Steps

What do you need to enroll in Community College?

- SS# or green card #
- Transcript is helpful
- Submitted your FAFSA (this is required for the Alameda Promise grant)

[Steps to Enroll page](#)

- 1) Create an account with [CCCApply](#)
- 2) Complete enrollment application to ONE college.
- 3) You may be prompted to register with [IDme](#) (you can decline this)
- 4) English & Math Placement Questionnaire (your transcript is helpful)
- 5) [Schedule an appointment with a counselor](#) (Students with an IEP or 504 Plan - [Schedule appt. with a SAS counselor](#))
- 6) Schedule your classes

Money for College:



You may be eligible for a \$500+ CalKIDS Scholarship. As a recent California public school student, you may be eligible to receive a CalKIDS Scholarship of \$500 to \$1,500 for higher education expenses. Use your SSID number to check your eligibility. [Link](#)

SENIORS:

- **Final Transcript:** How do my Final Transcript get sent to the school I am attending? **SCOIR!!!** Seniors need to login to SCOIR and update their "My Colleges" list of where they applied and update the results. Mark one school as "Enrolling" and that is where we will send your final transcript.
- **FAFSA/CADAA:** Community College bound students can still apply! September deadline for FAFSA/CADAA.

- 3) Are you applying to schools who will need letters of rec? Plan for that. Do you need a Counselor Rec? Complete the Counselor Packet over the summer.
- 4) Work on your [PIQs](#) and essays over the summer. Need help getting started?
