

Meeting Minutes – March 31, 2026

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by H. Murrah at 4:00 p.m.

2. Approval of Previous Minutes

Ms. Murrah read the minutes from the January 2026 meeting.

3. School Update

- Students in third through fifth grades are participating in a WIN time as we prep our students for the upcoming GMAS test. During collaborative planning teachers are working with Mrs. Ishee on Math mania to support rigor in math instruction.
- Mrs. Hughey discussed the current iReady growth monitoring results.
- “Level Up League” was described for the council. An initiative to get students ready for GMAS based on Beacon data.
- A breakdown of the current attendance was broken down. The council discussed ways to help improve attendance including an incentive for the parents to bring the children such as prize drawings like a Walmart gift card.
- There was a celebration mentioned as LFH completed IB re-evaluation and LFH is recertified for 5 years as an IB World School.

4. Title I Input/Revision

- Mrs. Courtright presented the council with Title I documents for review.
- While reviewing Title I documents it was brought to the attention of the council that often times we see a “poverty of relationships over poverty of resources.” A discussion began on how to help LFH families to be more in the know and what relationships could be formed and beneficial. Some ideas presented:
 - A “Help/Resource” pod document with helpful resources and tips for the area from current LFH parents.
 - Include a “Parent Pod Update” in the published monthly Dolphin Digest.
 - Promote the United Way more and relay all the resources and help they can supply.
