INTRODUCTION

At the International School of Florence, students ranging from Early Years 1 to Grade 10 must adhere to the school's uniform policy and dress code. This policy serves multiple purposes: enhancing school safety, fostering a stronger sense of identity and belonging among students, and showcasing the distinctiveness of our community. Crafted with meticulous attention to detail, our uniforms not only meet high standards of quality and comfort but also symbolize the unity within our school.

DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL REMARKS

1. Students are required to wear the designated uniform attire on school days, with exceptions made for special occasions like Field Day or themed events organized by the Student Council and endorsed by the school administration. Families will receive prior notification regarding such occasions.
2. The dress code applies throughout the entirety of the school day, including arrival and departure from school premises, unless otherwise authorized by the administration.
3. All articles of clothing must fit properly, be clean, without holes, tears, or frayed areas.
4. The requirements for the school uniform are the follows:
 - ISF logo tops (t-shirt, polo shirt, sweatshirt, ect). For example: if a sweatshirt is worn over a t-shirt, both items must have the ISF logo. Exception: winter jackets during extremely cold days.
 - an ISF logo bottom (pants, shorts, skort, etc).
 - all items must be purchased through the official and exclusive uniform supplier: LM School Uniforms (details below).
5. Parents are to ensure that every single item of their child's uniform is clearly marked on the inside with the child's name. The School does not assume any responsibility for lost or stolen items. It remains the responsibility of every student to ensure that they look after their belongings.
6. ALL shorts/skorts/dresses - Must fit properly and must be at maximum 2 cm above the knee. Please proceed in purchasing only the appropriate size based on your child's age.
7. ALL Pants - Must fit properly and be longer than the ankle. Pants and shorts shall be worn at the waist.
8. Undergarments including underwear shall not be visible.
9. No crop tops are allowed.



10. The school has spare uniform pieces available for a student who is not in the school uniform or does not follow the rules below. A parent or guardian will be required to bring appropriate uniform apparel to the school should any item of that particular size is not available.
11. Winter jackets and hats of a personal nature are permitted only during the winter season and solely outdoors. Inside the school premises, their wear is restricted unless weather conditions necessitate their use due to extreme cold.
12. Old style uniforms (i.e. ISF logo and writing in capital letter) and items produced by the previous supplier are no longer accepted. Only new style uniforms made by LM School Uniforms can be worn.
13. This regulation serves as a guide to permitted items and is not exhaustive in nature. It is understood that if something is not explicitly listed as permitted, it is considered prohibited. By attending ISF, students acknowledge that the Administration holds ultimate authority over the uniform policy.
14. Staff members conduct routine inspections to ensure compliance with the uniform policy, notifying families if the prescribed standards are not upheld.
15. Individuals within the ISF community, including students, staff, and community members, must obtain approval from the Head of School before designing, creating, or producing any attire for ISF clubs, programs, activities, or ECAs, whether to be worn on or off campus. Likewise, the unauthorized use of the ISF logo or branding for any purpose is prohibited without approval from the Head of School.
16. Please be advised that the School Administration reserves the right to alter, amend, or change this policy as necessary and has the final say in all matters regarding the School Uniform Policy.

UNIFORM ITEMS

Please find below a list of items and price list. Each student must own at least one item per each of the first three rows (i.e. 1 polo shirt, 1 sweatshirt, 1 sweater, 1 trousers/skirt) .

Since the uniform is mandatory, if a particular item is unavailable, parents must ensure that their child wears an alternative item of the uniform For example, if the short-sleeved white t-shirt is not available in your child's size, please purchase an alternative item such as the short-sleeved polo or the short-sleeved navy-blue t-shirt from the official store.

Concerning the **PE uniform**, the short sleeve top and shorts or skort are mandatory items, and students must wear them during scheduled PE classes. Students are required to wear the short-sleeve top and either shorts or a skort for all scheduled PE lessons. During colder months, the mandatory tracksuit top and pants are required to be worn instead for warmth. No other non-approved clothing items are permitted during PE classes.

Personal or non-ISF logo PE items are also prohibited during PE lessons.

Junior School students are required to wear the PE uniform for the entire day when they have PE. For Upper School students, the PE uniform is solely for PE lessons, and they are allowed to wear it when traveling to the Olympus sports center. However, students are expected to change back into the school uniform after PE.

UNIFORM INFRINGEMENTS

The ISF school uniform fosters a conducive learning atmosphere, enhancing students' sense of belonging and security within an inclusive setting. It instills school pride and endeavors to bolster overall well-being. Should a child be unable to wear the correct uniform for a brief duration due to extenuating circumstances, parents are advised to contact the homeroom teacher before the school term begins. In certain cases, parents may be notified, and the student may be asked to rectify their uniform before continuing with classes. Persistent violations will prompt parental notification for a discussion meeting.

The school provides spare uniform pieces for students who are not adhering to the school uniform policy outlined in this document. Any borrowed item provided to a student not in proper uniform will be on loan, and families are responsible for washing and returning the item to the school promptly. Failure to return the borrowed item will result in the family being charged the cost (as listed in the uniform prices below) for a replacement item.

DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS OF GRADE 11 AND 12 STUDENTS

Students in Grades 11 and 12 have the privilege of opting out of wearing the school uniform, which is subject to withdrawal. Nevertheless, it is expected that all students in Grades 11 and 12 dress in a respectful and suitable manner conducive to a learning environment. This encompasses, but is not confined to, refraining from wearing:

- Short or revealing attire
- Clothing with inappropriate or insensitive language
- Any items that could be perceived as culturally inappropriate or insensitive.



OFFICIAL AND EXCLUSIVE UNIFORM SUPPLIER



The official and exclusive ISF uniform supplier is [LM School Uniforms](#). The shop is located in Palazzo Frescobaldi in Via Santo Spirito, 11 Florence and is open Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 1:00pm and from 2:00pm to 6:00pm. In order to assist each family in the best possible way and to give time to try the items of the uniform, it is mandatory to book an appointment on the [online calendar](#) (PSW: ISF1952) to access the Boutique. Parents are offered a voucher for 1 hour parking at GARAGE LUNGARNO, Borgo San Jacopo, 10 prior booking. The voucher covers the fee for the 1st hour and the ZTL fee.

Please note that parking must be booked directly by the customer by calling +39 055 282542 and not through LM School Uniforms staff, who will only be responsible for providing the voucher.

Supplier's Presence in School

The supplier is on campus every Wednesday during peak periods or every two weeks to deliver orders directly to parents and assist any families who wish to place an order. Specific dates are communicated through the weekly Friday Flash and are always available in the dedicated section of the [school website](#).

Please note that not all the items models and sizes can be available in school during these dates, therefore it is important you place the online order or send an email or a WhatsApp message to +39 334 917 8774 by 4pm the day before their presence to the provider to ask for specific items and sizes to be brought to school if you want to make sure they are available for pick up.

Payment by the Customer who purchases through the [website](#) can be made by credit or debit card. The order will be considered valid at the time the payment is credited. Upon payment, an electronic invoice will be issued and will be available in the Customer's account and in their tax portal (cassetto fiscale).
