

High School Exam Schedule Spring 2025

- **Exemptions**
 - CTE and EOC exams may not be exempted.
 - Exam exemption status must be maintained up until the end of the day on **Monday, June 2.**
 - If a student elects to take an exam for which the student is eligible for exemption, the exam grade will be calculated as 20% of the final grade.
- **Attendance**
 - Students who wish to maintain perfect attendance must attend school on exam days.
 - Students will be marked absent if they do not attend the exam period. This includes students who have earned a credential in a CTE course who do not have to take the exam. **If this absence results in a 9th absence, the student will not receive credit for the course.**
- **Makeups**—Makeups due to illness will be arranged for the afternoons of exam days and/or on **Tuesday, June 3-Friday, June 6.**
- **Transportation**
 - Bus transportation will run at normal dismissal times each day.
 - Schools will develop local procedures for securing parental permission for students leaving as car riders after exams each day.
- **Lunch**—Lunch will be served each exam day.
- **Review Sessions**
 - Schools will decide and communicate any exam review sessions (in-person only) offered to students on the afternoon of each exam day.
 - Students who remain on campus are expected to attend the review session. School administration will provide procedures and expectations.
- **Credit Recovery/Initial Credit Edgenuity**
 - Students in credit recovery do not have to repeat the EOC or CTE exam regardless of their original score.
 - Students who have completed their courses and have **no more than 8 absences** are not required to attend the exam period.
 - If absence from the exam session results in a **9th absence, he/she will not receive credit for the course(s).**
 - All coursework must be completed by **Wednesday, June 4 (seniors) at 3:00 pm** and **Friday, June 6 (underclassmen) at 3:00pm.**
- **DDCC Courses**—Students enrolled in these courses will finish according to the *DDCC Exam Schedule*.
- **DCS eLearning Courses**
 - If perfect attendance is desired or the student has 8 absences, he/she must provide evidence of communication with the teacher on the exam day.
 - All students enrolled in an AP eLearn course will have the same final exam policy as in-person AP students.
 - eLearn students enrolled in a CTE or EOC must come in and take their exam(s) at their home base school.
- **NCVPS**
 - Students enrolled in an NCVPS course that has an EOC or CTE exam must be present in the exam period. Each school will decide where the exam will be administered.
 - If the NCVPS course does not have a required exam, the student will follow the guidelines above for Credit Recovery.
