



Memo to All Parents in Davidson County Schools Receiving Title I Funding Notification to Parents of Assessment Information

The Federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires school districts to notify parents/guardians of children attending any school receiving Title I funds of their right to request and be provided with information regarding any state or local educational agency policy regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by the state or local educational agency.

As a recipient of these funds, Davidson County Schools will provide you with assessment information in a timely manner upon your request. According to the law, we are to make widely available the following assessment information for each grade level served by the district:

- The subject matter assessed
- The purpose for which the assessment is designed and used
- The source of the requirement for the assessment
- The schedule for the assessment and the time and format for disseminating results

Davidson County Schools is committed to providing quality instruction for all students and does so by keeping parents informed of assessment information and the education of their child. Parents are welcome to request any of the information listed above at any time throughout the school year. As always, please let us know how we can provide the best education for your child.
