Lost and Damaged Items:

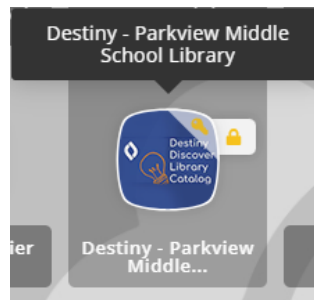
If students return books in damaged condition, or if books are lost/ unreturned, we ask that families pay for the replacement cost of these items so that other students may enjoy them in the future.

A notice will go out on **Tuesday, May 26th at 8:00am** to the student and family emails on file with all accrued charges. Payment should be made before the last day of school. If books are returned in good condition after payment has been made, families will be reimbursed.

How to check your account:

To see what books you may still have checked out...

1. Students should click on the **Destiny** icon in **Classlink** →
2. Login with your Google username/password
3. Click the **My Info** tab on the left side of the screen
4. Click on the **Patron Status** tab on the left side of the screen
5. Look under the **Items Out** and **Fines** headings to see what is still outstanding

Parkview Summer Library Checkout

Relax with a good book (or 15) this summer!

This year we are offering summer book checkout during the last 2 weeks of school.

How it works:

Any time on/after **Wednesday, May 27th**, come by the library before/after school or during class (if you are finished with all your work and with your teacher's permission) to select your summer books. You will be allowed to browse the shelves and choose **up to fifteen books**. We will check them out to you, and you can pick them up in the library at the end of that school day (so you don't have to lug them around). It's also a good idea to bring an extra bag/backpack to help carry the books home.

- You need permission. A responsible adult at home needs to know that you will have these books all summer so they can help you keep track of them - we want all of our books back!
- The library will be staffed during summer school. Students are free to exchange these books for additional titles during summer school hours.
- Summer checkout is available only to current Parkview students who have a consistently responsible library record. This means that if you had overdue materials this year, you took care of them in a timely manner.

6th and 7th Graders: All books are due by the end of the first week of school in the fall.

8th Graders: All books are due by Tuesday, June 30. Please make arrangements to have your books returned to the Parkview office/library by then.

Parents/Guardians:

Please sign and return this form to Mrs. Sawaski so your child can check out for the summer.

I give my Parkview student permission to check out up to fifteen books for the summer. I understand my student will be responsible for these items and should keep them in a safe place for the summer. All summer checkout books are due the first week of school (or by June 30 if the student was an 8th grader during the 2025-26 school year).
