Expectations for AIG Students

- AIG Students should be enrolled in rigorous coursework for their area of AIG identification.
- Rigorous coursework includes honors, Advanced Placement, and Career and College Promise courses.
- AIG students are expected to meet prerequisite requirements for rigorous courses.
- If an AIG student is not recommended for a rigorous course in their area of identification, parents/guardians may request a course placement waiver form from a school counselor or administrator.
