What It Is and What It's Not

-  **Limited access benefit** provided through Bridged
-  **Not comprehensive** health insurance - not a MEC plan
-  **Not a replacement** for major medical coverage

Eligibility FAQs

Who is eligible: Employees of participating districts who work at least 20 hours per week are eligible for the Bridged Essential Access benefit, even if they are not eligible for district-sponsored health insurance.

Who is not eligible: Employees who are covered under a High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) through a spouse or a parent are not eligible for this benefit.

No cost to the employee or district: The Essential Access benefit is provided at no cost to both the employee and the district and is administered directly through Bridged, separate from the district's medical plan.

ID cards: Employees enrolled in the benefit will receive an ID card for access to services.
