Annual Meeting of the Seneca Falls Central School District
Budget Vote, Election and Library Vote

The election inspectors present were Ted Novak, Patricia Novak, and Theresa Clark along with the District Clerk, Monica Kuney.

Ted Novak and Patricia Novak opened the voting machine. The annual meeting was called to order and the polls were declared open at Noon.

The polls were declared closed at 8:00 pm.

PROPOSITION 1 – 2025-2026 Budget YES: 262 (228 + 34) NO: 80(59 + 21)

Be it resolved, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to expend the sum of thirty-six million, eight-hundred eighty-six thousand, seven-hundred fifty-four dollars (\$36,886,754.00) in the 2025-2026 school year with such amount to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of such School District, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law.

PROPOSITION 2- 2025-2026 Purchase of Buses Proposition YES: 269 (229 + 40) NO: 72 (59 + 13)

Be it resolved, that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County is hereby authorized to purchase five (5) buses for the transportation of district students, for a sum of money not to exceed nine-hundred, ninety-five thousand dollars (\$995,000); said amount to be expended in the 2025-2026 fiscal year; said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be withdrawn from the district's "Capital Reserve Fund-Purchase of Buses" and/or the unassigned fund balance, in accordance with the Education Law and Local Finance Law.

PROPOSITION 3 - Technology Equipment & Infrastructure Capital Reserve Fund 2024 Expenditure YES: 277 (236 + 41) NO: 65(51 + 14)

RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Seneca Falls Central School District, Seneca County, NY is hereby authorized to withdraw from the "Technology Equipment & Infrastructure Capital Reserve Fund 2024" a sum of money up to One-Million, Five-Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) to be expended for technology equipment upgrades consistent with the authorizing resolution.

PROPOSITION 4 - Seneca Falls Library Tax Levy Increase YES: 252 (220 + 32) NO: 89(67 + 22)

Shall the sum of three hundred sixty-seven thousand dollars (\$367,000.00) be raised by annual levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the Seneca Falls Central School District for the purpose of funding the Seneca Falls Library?
