Summer School Overview

Marian Catholic Summer School for initial credit offerings will take place Monday, June 15 through Friday, July 24, 2026 at Marian Catholic.

Classes meet from 8:00 a.m. to Noon, Monday through Friday.

The following is an overview of the course offerings, registration procedure, and policies for summer school.

Initial Credit Courses

Initial credit course of World History, U.S. History, and Digital Literacy will be taught at Marian Catholic (Digital Literacy is for rising sophomores and incoming freshmen). Students who have failed a semester of World History or U.S. History can recover the credit at Marian, if possible. Driver's Education is no longer being offered at Marian Catholic.

Incoming freshmen (Class of 2030) who are not required to take Academic Skills are eligible to enroll in Digital Literacy or World History. **Students enrolled in initial credit courses will need an iPad for the class.** Members of the Class of 2030 who are required to take the Academic Skills Program will receive a separate summer school newsletter.

Credit Recovery Courses

Students who need to recover credits (if they failed a semester) for English 1, English 2, English 3, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Biology, Chemistry, or Theology will be provided information by their counselor about classes through Arrupe Virtual Learning Institute (AVLI), an on-line credit recovery program. ***(Counselors have registered students who failed first semester; students who fail second semester will be registered by their counselor by May 30th and tuition will be billed to FACTS.)*** Credit Recover will take place Wednesday, June 17 through Thursday, July 23, 2026. Students who are registered for these classes will take them at Marian Catholic during regular Summer School hours, under the supervision of a Marian Catholic faculty member.

Summer School Policies

Attendance: Classes meet from 8:00 am to Noon, Monday through Friday. It is mandatory that students attend class on a daily basis. Students who are absent more than one day may be withdrawn from the class without a tuition refund and no course credit will be given. If a student is absent, a parent call to the Main Office is required on the morning of the day of the absence. Students may not be absent on the day of the final exam. Vacations and outside sports camps should not be scheduled during Summer School dates and hours.

There is no school on Friday, June 19 (Juneteenth holiday), and Friday, July 3 (Independence Day holiday).

Grading: If the Summer School course is being taken for the first time, the grade and credit the student receives is posted and included in the calculations of a student's Grade Point Average. If the course is being repeated (credit recovery), the grade is posted on the transcript and the credit issued

Summer School Registration

Registration and course selection for Summer School initial credit courses is done on-line through the Summer School Registration Portal link (below) in this newsletter. Students recovering credits through Arrupe Virtual Learning Institute (AVLI) will receive that registration information directly from their academic counselor.

Course Enrollment is limited and students are accepted on a "first-come" basis. Please register early. Marian Catholic reserves the right to cancel classes if there is not sufficient enrollment. Complete refunds will be issued if a class is cancelled.

Tuition for Summer School classes (initial credit and credit recovery through AVLI) will be billed to the student's FACTS tuition account after their registration is submitted, and must be paid in full by June 10, 2026.

Digital Literacy runs for four weeks of Summer School: June 15 - July 10, 2026

This is a required one-semester course for graduation and is designed to provide the skills students need to successfully navigate the world of digital information and communication. The course reflects current digital literacy skills and introduces media literacy skills. Students will spend time critically evaluating information sources, practicing digital citizenship, and using a variety of digital tools to organize and create content. Key components of the course will include: proper and effective use of technology in our school setting, information literacy, digital citizenship, media literacy, digital communication, and creating and analyzing digital content. Students will apply digital literacy concepts to real-world situations and experiences providing them opportunities to practice digital skills through practical activities. This course must be completed by the end of sophomore year.

A minimum enrollment of 15 students is needed for the class to run, and total enrolment will be limited to 25 students.
