For students who need to recover credits they have *previously* failed to earn, ALL credits in the summer program apply toward graduation requirements.

Credit/ Grading:

- To earn a **PASS** on the transcript and a .5 credit, students must complete at least 60% of a course (Progress) at an achievement level (Relative Score) of 60%.
- To earn a **LETTER GRADE** on the transcript and a .5 credit, students must complete 100% of a course. The grade will be based on the achievement level (Relative Score) to earn an A (90%), B (80%), or C (70%).

NOTE: A PASS on a transcript is generally not accepted at most 4-year universities. A PASS is generally accepted at 2-year community colleges and training programs. If you are planning to apply for an Oregon Promise grant, you need a 2.0 cumulative GPA. A PASS will NOT impact your GPA, so you will need to meet the requirements to earn LETTER GRADES in your summer classes.

The summer program provides short and intensive instruction and support. We want all students to be successful! To support student focus and learning, students will be expected to follow these policies:

Attendance:

- **Absences:** There are no EXCUSED or UNEXCUSED absences in Summer School. **A student can miss no more than one class in a session to still earn the credit.** Any student sent home for any disciplinary action is considered absent for that day.
- **Tardies:** A student will be considered tardy if s/he arrives up to 10 minutes late for any class. More than one tardy can result in disciplinary action including possible removal of the class.

Technology Expectations: As a part of registering for summer school, I accept that I will only be able to access my credit recovery classes while in class at Schellenberg. I accept that I must bring my **district** Chromebook charged and ready for work every day. I accept there is no role for the use of Artificial Intelligence in credit recovery classes. I accept that Go Guardian will be used to monitor my computer use during class time. **I accept that the district's No Phone policy will be strictly enforced, and I will leave my phone at home or in a Yondr pouch.
