



MANALAPAN TOWNSHIP E-BIKE REGULATIONS



ENFORCEMENT BEGINS JULY 20, 2026

IN JANUARY 2026, NJ GOVERNOR MURPHY SIGNED S4834/A6235 INTO LAW, CREATING NEW REGULATIONS FOR E-BIKES IN NEW JERSEY. THE LAW REQUIRES BOTH "LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES" AND "MOTORIZED BICYCLES" TO BE LICENSED AND REGISTERED. UNDER THE LAW, RIDERS HAVE UNTIL JULY 19, 2026 TO COMPLY BY OBTAINING THE REQUIRED LICENSE AND REGISTRATION THROUGH THE NEW JERSEY MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION.

WHO

does this effect?

- Ages 17+: Must have a drivers license.
- Ages 15-16: Need special motorized bicycle license.
- Under 15: E-bike use is not permitted.
- All riders, regardless of age, are required to wear a helmet.

WHAT

is changing?

- New E-bike laws will go into effect 7/20.
- E-bikes must be registered with NJMVC and riders must carry liability insurance.
- Minimum age requirements for E-bike use.
- Speed/power modifications are banned.

WHEN

is the deadline?

- January 2026:
 - Law passed.
- January–July 2026:
 - Compliance grace period.
- July 20, 2026:
 - Enforcement begins.

is this law in effect?

WHY

did the law change?

- Increase in serious crashes and fatalities.
- Please note, fines start around \$50+ per violation.

HOW

do I become compliant?

- Visit the NJMVC to ensure your family is compliant with licensing and insurance requirements before July 20, 2026 to avoid violation fees.
