TUITION AND FEES

Mercy Academy's tuition for the 2026-27 school year is \$16,900. Scholarships and financial assistance for those who qualify are then applied to reduce this amount. There is no interest charged on any of our tuition payment plans. Mercy Academy partners with FACTS Management Company for tuition collection and incidental billing. Your checking or savings account will be electronically charged for the tuition due.

Should a student leave Mercy for any reason during the school year, parents/guardians are responsible for tuition according to the following schedule:

25% of tuition due from first day of school – 9/30
 50% of tuition due from 10/1 – 11/30
 75% of tuition due from 12/1 – 1/31
 100% of tuition due for withdrawal after 1/31

PAYMENT POLICY

All accounts must be current in order to:

- View midterm grades and return second semester
- View final grades at the end of the year
- Participate in graduation and receive a diploma
- Obtain a transcript
- Return the following year

INCLUSIVE LUNCH

Mercy Academy collaborates with FLIK Independent School Dining to provide a daily lunch INCLUDED in the price of the tuition for ALL students on school days when lunch is served. FLIK's chef and dietitian work with families to accommodate all dietary needs and food allergies.

DIGITAL LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Mercy Academy requires all students to purchase an iPad through the school. After the first year, the iPad is paid for and there are no additional technology fees.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION

Mercy Academy proudly awards over \$1 million in financial assistance annually. We encourage families to apply for financial aid by following the steps outlined below:

- Complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application for Mercy Academy.
- Financial aid applications are due by December 31 for priority consideration and families will receive an email notification from FACTS on March 1 letting them know their financial aid award status.
- Financial aid applications received after December 31 will be reviewed as funding allows.

Returning families: Your student must be registered for the fall semester, including payment of registration fee and current on tuition for 2025-26 in order to receive financial aid notification from the school.

Need-Based Financial Aid:

Generous support from the Mercy Academy community places a crucial role in making financial aid awards possible.

Mercy Day Scholarships:

Mercy Day Scholarships are made possible through the generosity of members of the greater Mercy community. These scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. In order to be selected for a Mercy Day Scholarship, families must apply and qualify for financial assistance (determined by FACTS) and complete a scholarship application. Incoming freshmen and current students are invited to apply.

Merit-Based Scholarships:

Mercy offers a tiered academic scholarship for those who score highly on the high school placement test:

1st place: \$3,000

2nd place: \$2,500

3rd place: \$2,000

All students in the 90th percentile: \$1,000

*These scholarships are renewable all four years for students who remain in good academic standing.

Sisters' Discount:

Families with more than one student attending Mercy at the same time will receive \$2,000 off the oldest student's tuition.
