Progress on our 2024 - 2025 SIC Goal

Our School Improvement Council has continued to meet regularly via Google Meet throughout the 2024-2025 school year. It was agreed upon that virtual meetings were the preferred and most convenient way to meet. The council is very proud of our teachers, students and families for demonstrating resilience, creativity, and collaboration throughout this school year as we achieved "Excellent" on our SC state report card for the fourth year in a row! We have also been the recipient of the Palmetto Gold Achievement Award for two years.

Due to the unique needs of our student demographic, the council decided to focus on supporting our Hispanic families through specific, bilingual parent meetings each month. Meeting topics include attendance policies, immunization requirements, technology resources, schooling options, etc. These meetings have been well-attended and the feedback received has been extremely positive. We also developed specific resources for parents that were shared at parent/teacher conferences in multiple languages so parents understood their child's progress and were equipped with ways to support their learning.

For next year, the council will specifically focus on parental involvement including ways of informing parents about specific study topics and events in the classroom and providing them with opportunities to volunteer in the school setting.
