BUILDING FOUNDATIONS: NUMBER SENSE AND PLACE VALUE

This session explores how rich mathematical experiences can help students develop strong number sense and a deep understanding of place value. Through hands-on activities and collaborative problem solving, participants will examine ways to support students in thinking flexibly about numbers — understanding their size, relationships, and multiple representations — and using that understanding to reason about and perform number operations. Rather than focusing on memorization, this session emphasizes creating meaningful mathematical experiences that allow number sense to emerge naturally through exploration, discussion, and play.
