POSITION DESCRIPTION

We seek a part-time (.2 FTE) Latin teacher for the 2026-2027 academic year to teach one course.

Duties and responsibilities include:

- Teaching one of our full-credit Latin courses. Full-credit courses meet 4 times a week for 40 minutes per class.
- Working closely with our full-time Latin teacher to coordinate curriculum and assessments.

The annual (ten-month school year) salary for this position ranges from \$17,000-\$20,000, depending on relevant experience.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

Firmly committed to establishing culturally responsive classrooms, we seek teachers who think independently and love learning, especially alongside high school students. Teacher certification is not required. In addition, strong candidates will demonstrate a commitment to equity and inclusion in a diverse community and show a keen interest in collaborating with colleagues while mentoring young people.

We offer personalized and sustained onboarding, including close work with a peer mentor and regular meetings with the Assistant Head of School and the Dean of Faculty Hiring and Support.
