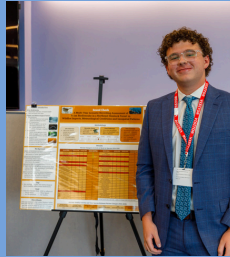

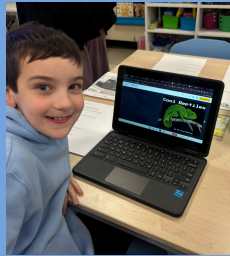
2026-2027 BUDGET FAST FACTS

The 2026-2027 Proposed Budget includes a 3.63% tax levy increase, which supports an estimated 2.18% increase in the tax rate. This is the 15th consecutive tax-cap compliant budget.

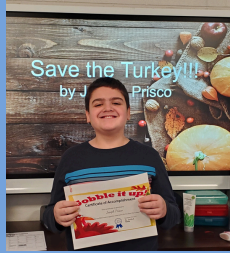
* Actual tax rate is set by the Town in August 2026. **Based on an average assessment of \$8,500.

The 2026-2027 proposed budget builds on a strong foundation and our strategic plan's vision, delivering for students at every level and reflecting our commitment to continuous improvement across the district.



- **Academic enhancements:** continued implementation of literacy and math programs already producing measurable gains districtwide, Spanish and Italian instruction expansion to grades K-2, additional sections of Algebra, Biology, and Spanish at WMS, launch of Syracuse University Project Advance dual enrollment at WHS, Personal Finance Education at WMS and WHS, and The Harbor, a new structured support program for students experiencing emotional challenges
- **Comprehensive security measures:** continued School Resource Officer, full-time security coordinator, expanded cameras, 30 additional radios, formalized threat assessment teams, an additional security officer, and a new security booth at the Westlake campus entrance
- **Strategic facility improvements:** construction underway at Hawthorne and WHS classroom additions at Hawthorne and Columbus, and finalization of an Energy Performance Contract to bring air cooling to WMS through savings made possible by solar energy
