FAQ's



1. How much does registration cost?

The registration fee is \$100 per player.

This fee helps cover:

- Clayton/Olivette League team registration
- League operations
- Field use and maintenance
- Jerseys
- Insurance and administrative costs

Our goal is to keep fees as affordable as possible while maintaining a safe and high-quality program.

2. Why are team sizes limited?

Teams are limited to approximately 12–15 players to:

- Ensure meaningful playing time for all athletes
- Support skill development and instruction
- Maintain player safety and appropriate supervision
- Smaller roster sizes allow coaches to better support each child and create a positive experience for everyone.

3. What happens if teams fill up?

Once rosters are full, we cannot add additional players to that team.

If interest exceeds capacity:

- Families may be placed on a waitlist
- If spots open or additional programming becomes available, waitlisted families will be contacted
- We encourage families to register early to secure a spot.

4. What if my family cannot afford the registration fee?

We do not want cost to be a barrier to participation.
