School Board Meeting Highlights
May 11, 2026

At the May 11, 2026 Regular Meeting of the School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. **Student Recognition**. The School Board celebrated the achievements of middle schoolers who participated in History Day at the state and national level, along with high school students for their accomplishments in the Hennepin Arts Spotlight Showcase.

2. **Historically Black Colleges and Universities Tour Summary**. A team of WBLAHS staff members and students provided a recap of the transformative trip taken by the White Bear Lake Area Schools Black Student Union (BSU) this spring. The group participated in a tour of several Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), an experience designed to broaden post-secondary horizons and celebrate cultural heritage. The group provided a recap of the journey, highlighting student engagement with admissions officers, tours of historical landmarks, and meaningful dialogue with collegiate mentors.
