The Driver Education Program consists of thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction, four (4) hours of range and two (2) hours of road driving. A letter explaining the driving portion will be sent home on the first day of class. Range and Road driving will be held in the FCS driving range across from the Floyd County Board of Education. All six (6) hours of driving will be completed in one (1) day.

PLEASE NOTE Breakfast and lunch IS NOT provided. We will break for lunch each day at 11:30am.

Upon successful completion of the requirements, each student who has completed the eighth grade may receive one-half Carnegie unit of credit if it is their choice to receive a numerical grade between 70 - 100 for this course. Otherwise, the student may choose to receive a pass / fail grade that will not affect their GPA.

- Students must be **at least 15 years old** and hold a valid learner's permit to be eligible to complete the driving portion of the class.
- Students must **bring pencils and pens to class**. Notebooks will be provided.
- **Cancellations** after registering will be charged a \$25.00 cancellation fee.
- ALL **refunds** will be mailed once all the Driver Education classes have been held. Refunds must be requested by Friday, June 12th.
- Students **missing their range or road driving** "hour slot" will be charged an additional **\$50.00 fee PER HOUR MISSED**.

Summer Registration begins immediately. Online registration and payment are preferred and strongly encouraged.
