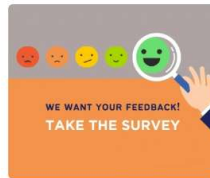


## Do you want to volunteer for Field Day?

To access the survey, you will need to create a **PowerSchool Parent Portal** account. Your child brought home confidential information for account access (with your 3rd Quarter Report card). This includes a student number, username, and password, which is needed to set up your account.

Once your account is created, please take a few moments to complete the survey. You will also gain access to valuable information such as your child's **grades (1st-5th), attendance, and more**—making it a great tool to stay connected to your child's progress now and throughout the school career.

### Accessing the 2026 Parent and Guardian School Climate Survey form through the browser:

1. Navigate to the Parent Portal login page.
  2. Enter your username and password to log in.
- Note:** Contact your district administrator if you do not have a Parent Portal account.
3. Select the Forms link from the left-hand Navigation bar.
  4. The 2026 SCDE School Climate Survey form will appear on the 'General Forms' tab.
  5. Click on the form titled '**2026 PARENT AND GUARDIAN SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY**' to open the form.
  6. Click on the link within the form to access, complete, and submit the survey.

### Accessing the 2026 Parent and Guardian School Climate Survey form through the PowerSchool Mobile App:

\*\*Please make sure you are on the most recent version of the app prior to logging in.

1. Locate your district code. This can be found in the bottom left corner of the Parent Portal.

**Note:** Contact your district PowerSchool administrator if you cannot locate your district code.

2. Navigate to the PowerSchool App on your mobile device.
3. Enter district code and submit.
4. Enter your username and password to log in.
5. On the dashboard, select More.

**Note:** You can click Edit and drag the Forms icon to the navigation bar to organize tabs

6. Click Forms to access forms that have been shared to your account.
7. The 2026 SCDE School Climate Survey will appear in the General Forms tab.
8. Click on the 2026 Parent and Guardian School Climate Survey to open the form.
9. Complete and submit the survey.
