

Senior Farmers' Market Vouchers for Dodge County - 2026

The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides eligible seniors with vouchers to use at area farmers' markets and participating roadside stands to help stretch their food dollars.

You must be **60 years of age** or older (or a Native American 55 or older) and reside in **Dodge County**. Household income must be at or below 185% of the federal poverty level:

- 1 person: \$2,461 monthly / \$29, 526 annual income
 - 2 persons: \$3,337 monthly / \$40, 034 annual income
 - 3 persons: \$4,212 monthly / \$50,542 annual income
 - 4 persons: \$5,088 monthly / \$61,050 annual income
 - For each additional household member, add \$876 monthly / \$10,508 annually
- Each eligible participant will receive **\$25 in vouchers** to use at eligible farmers' markets to purchase only Wisconsin-grown fruits, vegetables, and herbs.

Vouchers will be distributed on a **"first-come, first-served"** basis at several locations around the county, and there will be vouchers reserved for each location. If more people show up than the allocated vouchers, we will create a waiting list in case more vouchers are available later. **Vouchers can be picked up by an Authorized Representative; if you plan to designate an Authorized Representative, you will need to complete an Eligibility Agreement Form, which must be signed by both you and the Authorized Representative. To request a copy of the form by mail, please give us a call. An Authorized Representative can represent up to four (4) individuals.**

Vouchers cannot be mailed. Please make every effort to attend one of the distribution locations or designate an Authorized Representative (see above). **Vouchers must be redeemed by October 31, 2026.** Vouchers can be picked up at the following locations:
