## Audience Code of Conduct

It is the right of every senior and all other involved persons to expect a dignified commencement worthy of their time, effort, and financial investment. This occasion should reflect the highest possible excellence in accordance with established etiquette and protocol. Anything less defeats the real purpose and nullifies the unique educational value of commencement. To provide deserving, memorable moments to be treasured throughout the life span of the graduates, there must be cooperation between participants, planners, and the audience. The audience can pay their personal love and respect to their loved ones, as well as to all graduates, by following the guidelines listed below:

1. Do not reserve seats by placing personal possessions in them. Occupy only the seats in which you, your family, and your guests are seated.
2. Follow the directions of the ushers and guides.
3. When names are called to issue diplomas, it is important that each family has an opportunity to hear its graduate's name. Save your applause until all diplomas and honors have been presented.
4. Refrain from blocking the view of others by standing, taking photographs, bringing balloons into the venue, or otherwise obstructing the processional.
5. Refrain from any conduct that might detract from the ceremony (catcalls, yelling, obscene gestures, etc.).
6. Use common courtesy in relation to other members of the audience.
7. Remain seated for the recessional.

NOTE: Any person suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol is subject to removal by the proper authorities.
