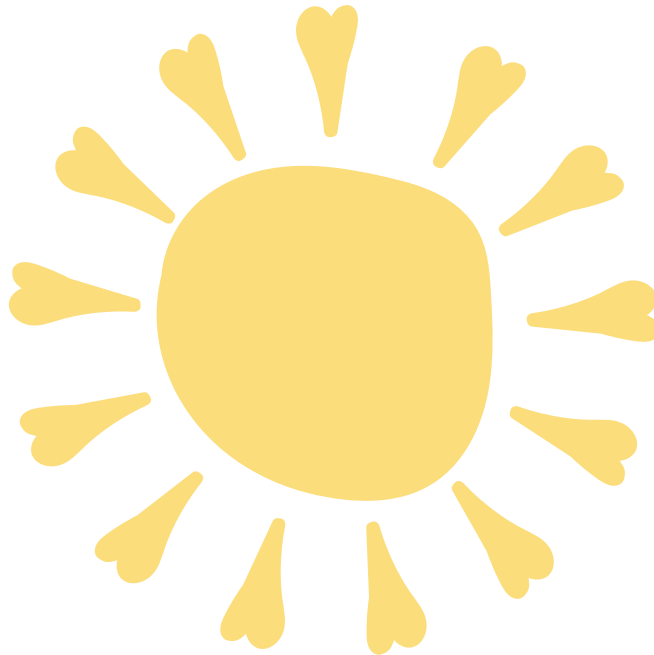
MARCHING BAND

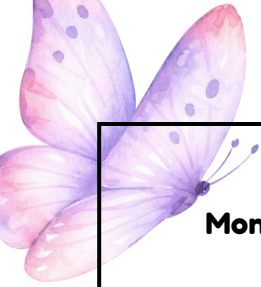

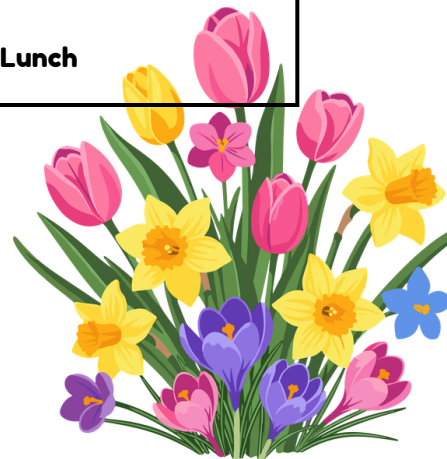
