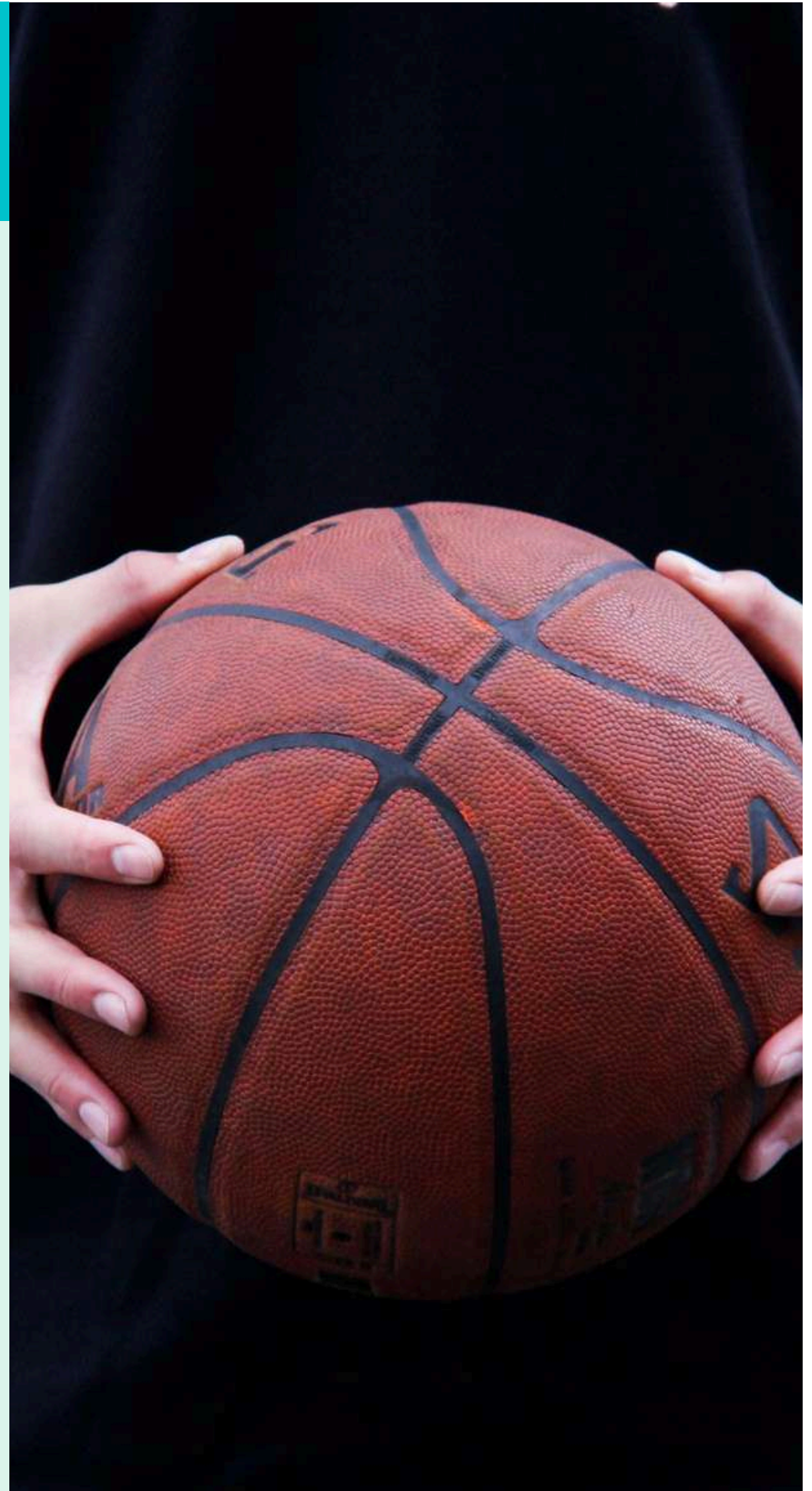
Padel Tennis

Adventure Farm and Salting Rubí.



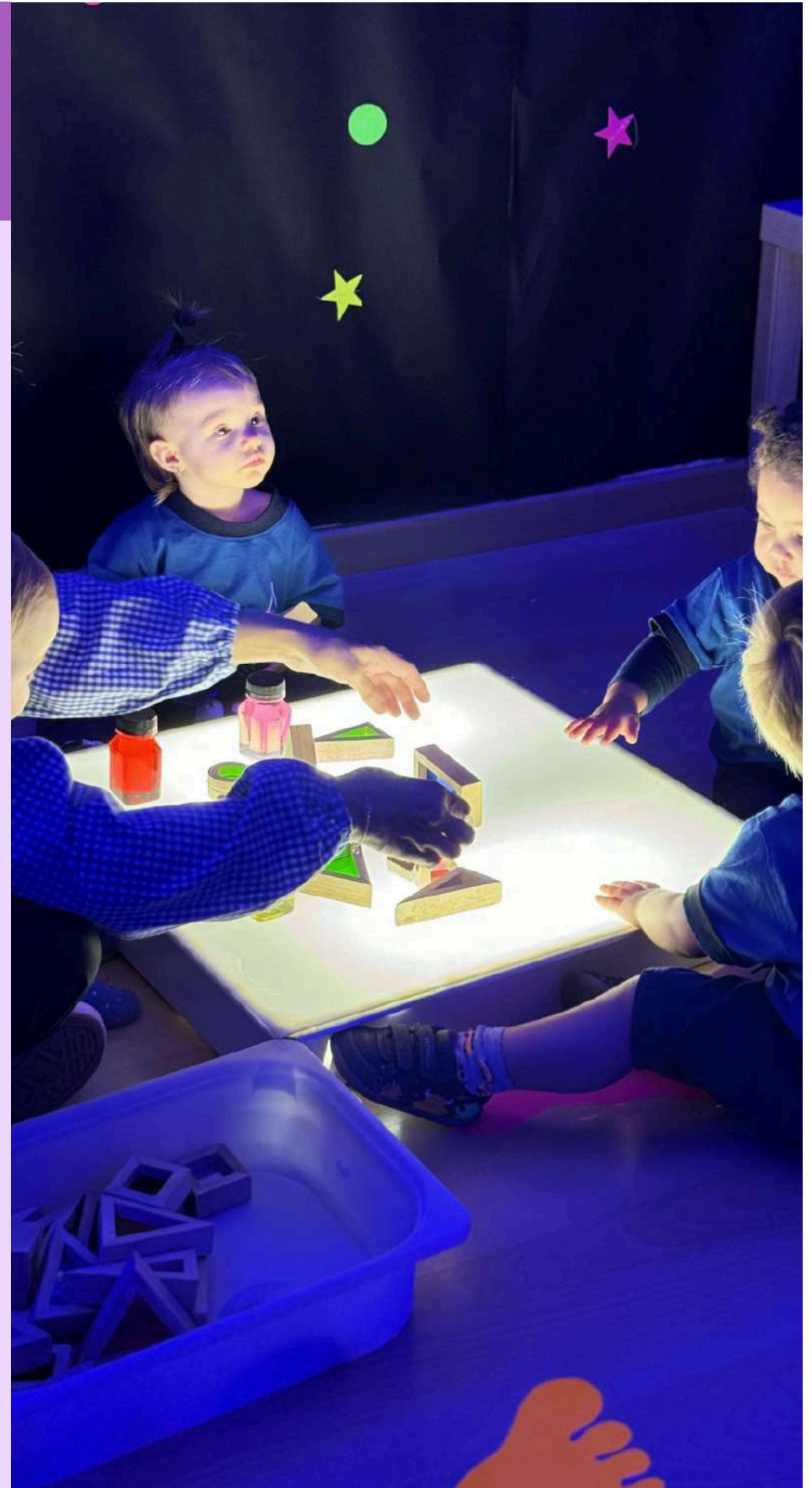
Surf Campus - Portugal

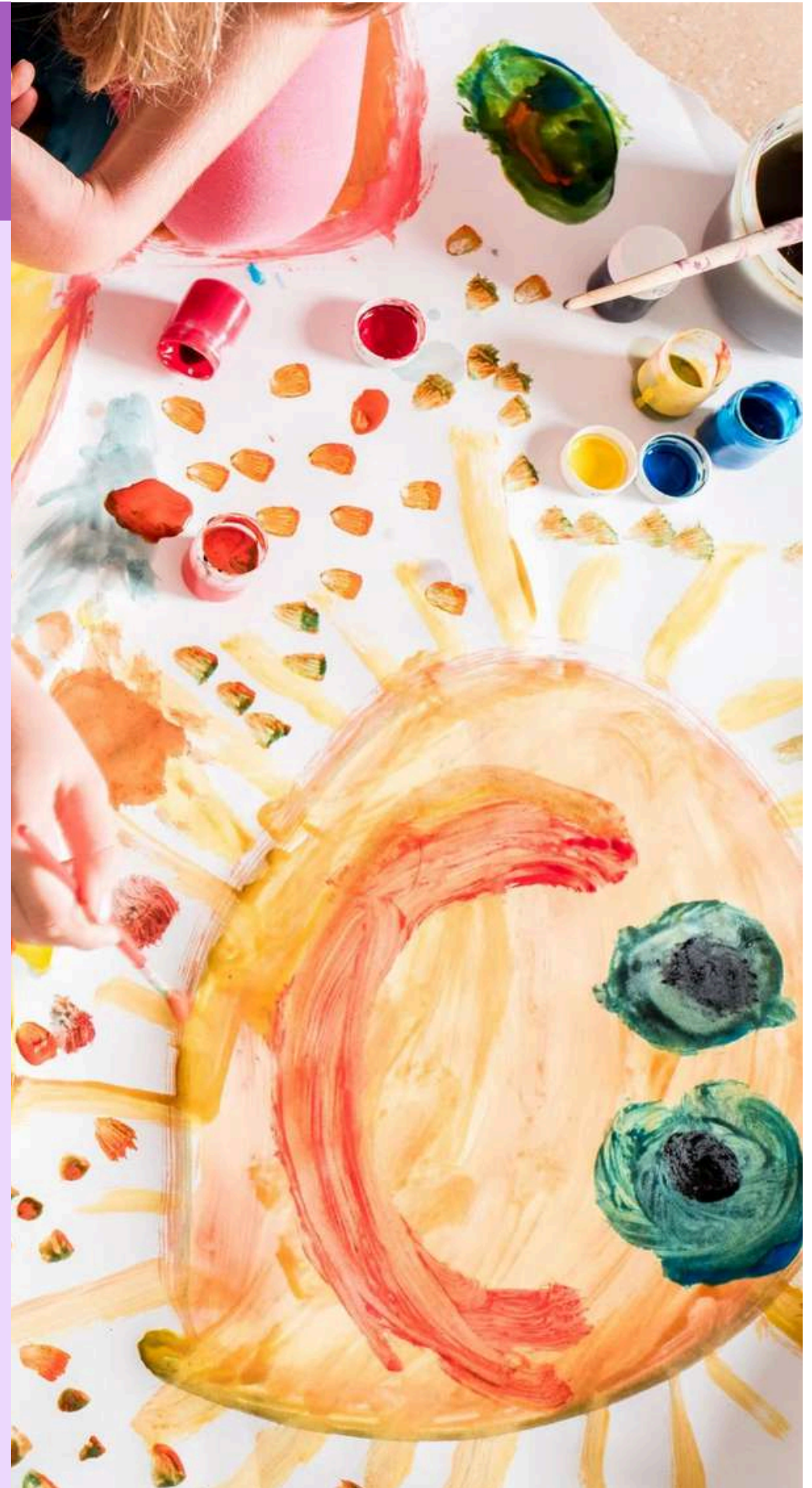
The Adventure Factory

 - Understand what the bid-ask spread is and how it works.



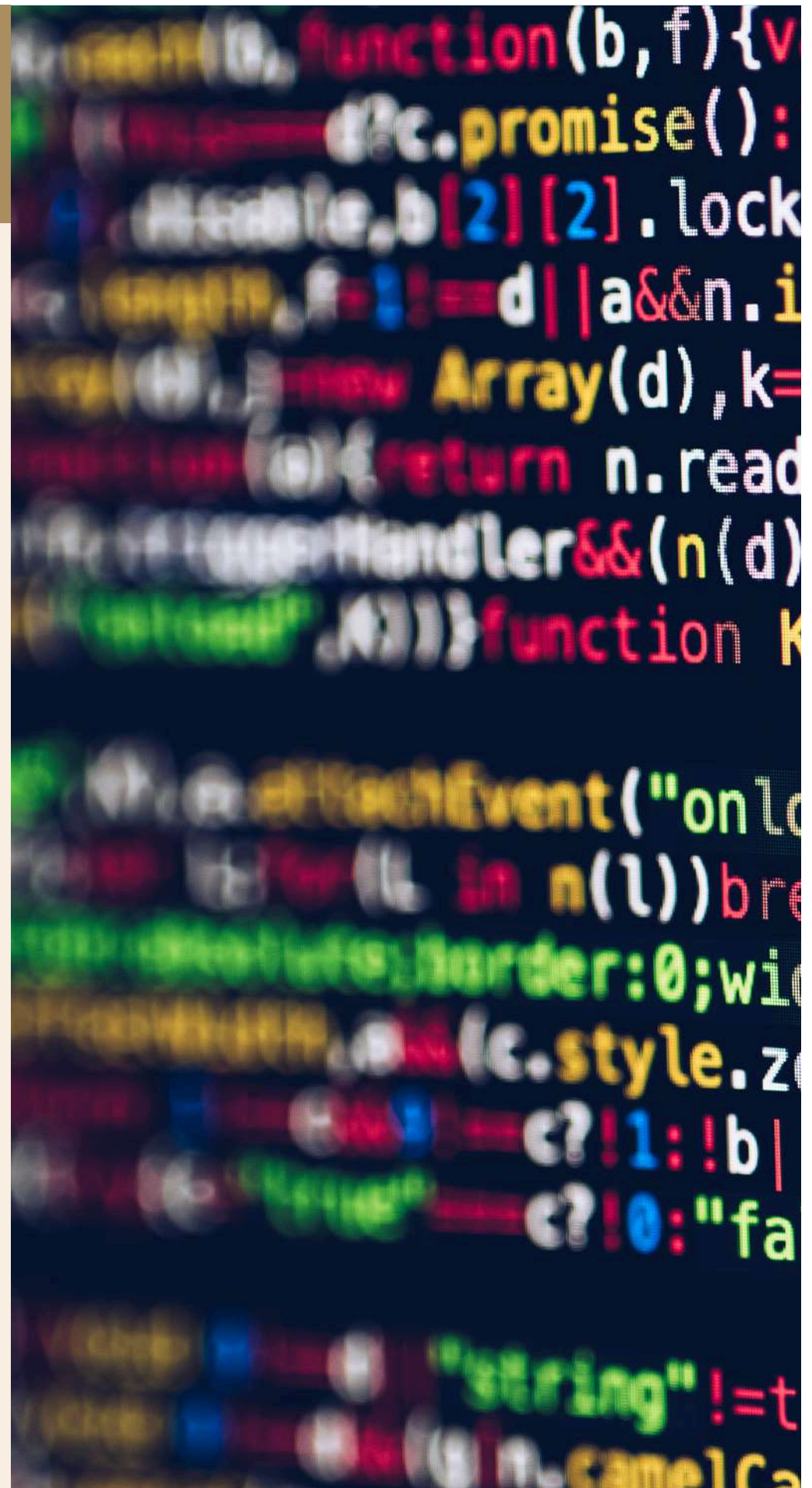
Virtual Reality & Drones
