Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Scarborough Public Schools Pre-K program, students must meet the following criteria:

- The child must be a resident of Scarborough.
- The child must turn four (4) years old on or before October 15, 2026.

Our Pre-K program is designed to foster early literacy and numeracy skills, social-emotional development, and a love for learning in a supportive and engaging environment. We believe in nurturing each child's unique potential and preparing them for a successful transition to kindergarten.

As we begin preparing for this transition, I would like to inform you of the process we will follow to select a new Assistant Superintendent.

Hiring Timeline:

- May 14 – Job posting opens and will remain active until May 25.
- May 15 – This notice is being sent to parents and staff inviting you to apply to be part of the interview team for the first round of interviews. (Applications to be on the interview team are due by May 22.) [Please fill out this form if you would like to be considered to be part of the Interview team](#)
- May 22 – Notification to those selected to be on the interview team
- May 28 – Interview team meeting, from 1:00-2:00 PM
- May 28 – First round interviews will be held between 2:00 PM and 8:00 PM (exact timing will depend on the number of candidates selected for interviews).

- Week of June 1st – Second round interviews.

First Round Interview Team:

The work of this team is to select 2 finalists to move to the second round district team for consideration. The team for the first round of interviews will consist of the following members:

- 4 school staff members, representing each of the phase levels: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12
- 1-2 district-wide staff members
- 1-2 building leaders
- 1 district leader
- 1-2 parent representatives or community members
- 1 school board member

SPS Students Selected to Represent ME on Special Olympics YAC



Scarborough Public Schools, in collaboration with Special Olympics Maine, proudly announces the selection of four Scarborough High School students to the **Special Olympics Maine Youth Activation Committee (YAC)**. The students chosen for this leadership role are rising seniors Eleanor Bannon and Jackson Peters, rising junior Grace Leasure, and rising freshman Scarlet Leighton.

The Youth Activation Committee comprises high school students dedicated to promoting inclusion across Maine schools. Through Unified programming, YAC members work to create accepting school environments that amplify the voices and contributions of all students, including those with intellectual disabilities. Selection to the committee is a competitive process, recognizing students' involvement in Unified and inclusion initiatives, as well as their demonstrated leadership and communication skills.

Scarborough Public Schools actively supports inclusive programming, offering Unified sports (Basketball, Volleyball, Bocce) and clubs (The Buddy System, Unified Club) at both the high school and middle school levels. As YAC members, these students will lead annual Youth Summits, spearhead the "Spread the Word" campaign to eliminate derogatory language, and organize Olympic Village activities at the State Summer Games. They may also represent Maine at national events.

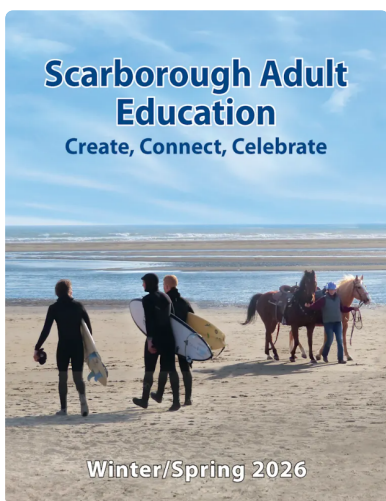
2026 -2027 School Calendar
