

## Curriculum Committee Meeting Minutes (5/11/2026)

*Call to order:* 5:32 PM by K. Hill

**Approval of Agenda/Public Comment:** A motion was made to approve the agenda as written, seconded, and approved unanimously. No public present.

### AI Update

- Update about a recent presentation/professional development (Mike Berry, Roxbury School District) to all teachers regarding AI use in the classroom. Mixed results from staff.
- One representative from each school did an 8-hour training (individually) with M. Berry about how to use AI, or not, in the classroom. The goal is for each rep to help train others within each school.
- Questions/Discussion Notes:
  - What was Mike Berry's goal; that we use AI or avoid it? The first goal is needing to teach students to use AI. The district has adopted new state-level AI guidance. At the elementary level, students will learn about AI, but will not interact. At the secondary level, with strong teacher guidance, students could, eventually, use AI. Still a focus on pen and paper with possible development of ideas using AI and specified prompts.
  - Now using "GoGuardian" to track student use on Google Docs and monitor use of, or lock students out of, AI programs.
  - M. Berry discussed other programs to track student computer use with AI, especially regarding the emotional guidance students are increasingly relying on.
  - Everything still new and still underway; professional development still needed

### Report Cards

- There's been feedback from families/teachers about elementary report cards and inconsistencies from teacher to teacher about comments.
- Looking to recommend comments be unique for each individual student using specific proficiency-based language.
- Consensus that guidance would be welcomed to streamline the process for teachers.
