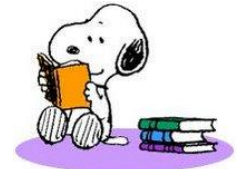

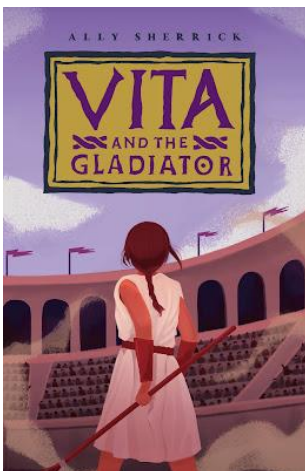
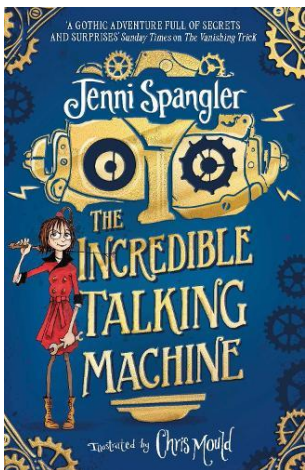

Then this could be the opportunity for you!

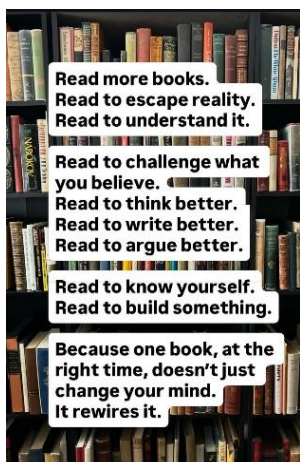
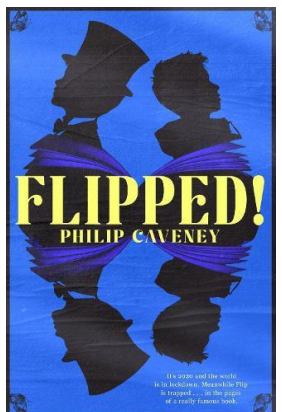
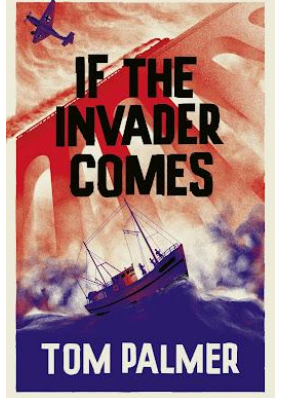
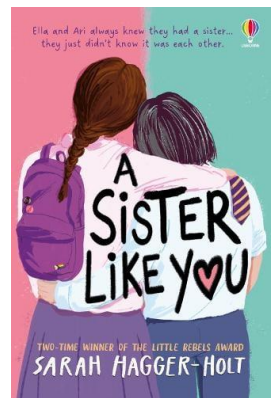
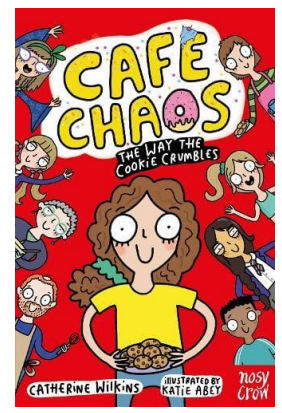
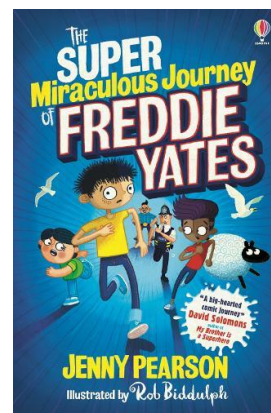
