



Learn How Summer EBT Can Help Your Family!



Summer EBT is a grocery benefits program to help families buy food during the summer when schools are closed. Families get **\$120** for each eligible school-age child. Children who get these benefits can still participate in other summer meal programs.

How does Summer EBT work?

In Wisconsin, Summer EBT benefits are loaded onto an EBT card and mailed to your home; added to an existing household SNAP EBT card, etc. Summer EBT benefits can be used to buy food like fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains, and dairy at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other places that accept SNAP EBT benefits. Summer EBT is a convenient way to help children get the nutrition they need when schools are closed.



Is my child eligible for Summer EBT?

Your child is eligible for **Summer EBT** if:

- Your household already participates in **SNAP, FDPIR, TANF, etc.** OR
- Your child attends a school that offers the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Program, and your household income meets the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals.

Do you have a new address?

Make sure your address is up to date so your **Summer EBT** benefits are sent to the right place!

How do I enroll my child in Summer EBT?

Many families get **Summer EBT** automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply.

Do I need to fill out an application?

If your household already participates in **SNAP, FDPIR, TANF, etc.**, your child will be automatically enrolled in **Summer EBT**. You do not need to fill out an application. You will **get a card in the mail, or the money will be added to your SNAP EBT card**. Watch for the **card in the mail/added benefits on your card**.

If you are not automatically enrolled and believe your children are eligible, you can apply for **Summer EBT**.

When applying, you will be asked to provide your child's name, school, date of birth, and address. You will also be asked to report your household income. You will not need to provide any other documents or information including **social security number, pay stub**.
